NEW MEDICAL OFFICE OPENS IN BLOOMFIELD

Provides Seven-day Service

(BLOOMFIELD, Conn.) – Saint Francis Hospital and Medical Center has opened a new medical facility in Bloomfield at Copaco Plaza. Located at 421 Cottage Grove Road, Bloomfield, the facility is home to primary care, urgent care, laboratory and specialty services.

The Urgent Care Center is open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m., and Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. The 3,400-square-foot Center provides care for minor emergencies as well as routine medical needs, such as physicals and vaccinations. It is staffed by two board certified physicians, Gilberto Ramirez, M.D., and Eric Goldberg, M.D. Dr. Ramirez is a diplomate of the American Board of Internal Medicine and completed his residency training at Saint Francis.
