Yale-New Haven Health appoints new CEO for Northeast Medical Group

NEW HAVEN, CT - August 20, 2010 - Yale New Haven Health System has hired Robert A. Nordgren, MD, as the first chief executive officer for Northeast Medical Group (NEMG), Yale New Haven Health System's medical foundation. Northeast Medical Group is a system-wide physician group that was developed in 2010 to support the delivery of better integrated, safe, high quality care with the physicians who practice at System facilities. Currently there are 200 physicians employed by NEMG in the Greenwich, Bridgeport and Yale-New Haven Hospital service areas.

Dr. Nordgren, who will join NEMG in late September, was previously associate medical director at Dartmouth-Hitchcock Manchester in New Hampshire and an adjunct faculty member of the Dartmouth Medical School department of pediatrics. He also served as the executive director of child health services in Manchester. He is very active in community and statewide health initiatives, health care reform and children's health programs in New Hampshire.

He received his undergraduate degree from Williams College and his MPH and MD from Columbia University. He trained at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, serving in his final year as chief resident in pediatrics. He is a board-certified pediatrician. Dr. Nordgren is currently enrolled in the MBA program at the University of Massachusetts Amherst Isenberg School of Management/American College of Physician Executives.
