Services include primary and preventive care; pediatric subspecialty services; emergency, acute, and intensive care; and surgery, rehabilitation, and care for children with chronic conditions.

A teaching facility affiliated with the University of Connecticut School of Medicine, the medical center conducts a residency program in pediatrics and a fellowship in orthopaedics. The state-of-the-art building opened April 2, 1996 and features a child and family-friendly design, including all private rooms with rooming-in for parents.

A Circle of Caring for Children

The mission of Connecticut Children's Medical Center is to provide comprehensive pediatric services to children as close to their own doorsteps as possible. Working in collaboration with community hospitals around the state, Connecticut Children's has created a "circle of caring" that improves access to pediatric specialty care.

Through formal affiliation agreements with 10 community hospitals, Connecticut Children's Medical Center brings pediatric specialty expertise and services to local communities. It enhances pediatric continuing education for physicians, nurses, and other clinical staff. The affiliations establish lines of communication for consultation and enables pediatric specialists from Connecticut Children's faculty to conduct clinics for outpatients by appointment.

These services are a logical outgrowth of the regional system of pediatric care that was developed by the University of Connecticut School of Medicine Department of Pediatrics in the early 1970s. This model has enhanced the delivery of pediatric specialty services to community hospitals in the northern half of the state.
