Griffin Hospital, the flagship hospital of the Planetree membership network, continues to build on the strong foundation it has established over the past decade.

Griffin Hospital is dedicated to creating an exceptional patient experience through its patient-centered Planetree model of care and its commitment to achieving superior clinical outcomes and industry leading performance. Griffin received a “Best Acute Care Hospital Award” from Total Benchmark Solution, LLC, one of the leading providers of benchmarking and consulting services for healthcare organizations. The award recognized Griffin’s performance in the care provided to heart attack, heart failure, and pneumonia patients, three of the performance indicators tracked nationally by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). Griffin was also recognized as a 2007 Premier/Care Science Select Practice National Quality Leader for demonstrating superior clinical outcomes and exceptional efficiency in patient care. Of more than 4,700 hospitals considered for this award, only 49 hospitals were selected in 2007, putting Griffin Hospital’s performance in the top 1% of hospitals nationwide.

Griffin’s website features a “Performance Indicator” section that displays CMS quality indicators as well as a host of other quality and performance data, accreditations, HCAHPS patient satisfaction ratings, and results of community surveys. The website is designed to provide what the public is seeking – information that allows them to be participants in their care and to compare the performance of hospitals on various indicators of quality and customer service.

Griffin Hospital and Planetree have received extensive media coverage for providing personalized, humanistic healthcare in a unique healing environment. Over the past decade, teams from more than 600 hospitals and other organizations have visited Griffin to see its unique healing environment and learn about its Planetree patient-centered model of care. The Planetree national headquarters is based at Griffin Hospital, and national and international interest in Planetree continues to grow. The Planetree membership network currently numbers more than 140, including hospitals, long-term care facilities, outpatient clinics, and health resource libraries in the U.S. and abroad.

Griffin, an employer of choice for healthcare professionals, is the only hospital in the nation to make FORTUNE magazine’s list of “100 Best Companies to Work for in America” for nine consecutive years. FORTUNE ranked the hospital #4 overall in 2006, Griffin’s highest ranking yet and the highest ranking ever achieved by a hospital.

Based on its reputation for innovative programs and its patient-centered care model, Griffin has also become a hospital of choice for physicians. Griffin continues to expand and enhance its comprehensive range of inpatient and outpatient services to attract the best and brightest physicians. The new 49,000 square foot Center for Cancer Care at Griffin Hospital and adjoining Hewitt Pavilion, which opened in October 2008, serves as the gateway to Griffin’s future. The new facility brings comprehensive cancer care – including radiation oncology services – closer to home for residents of Griffin’s community. The adjoining Hewitt Pavilion will house the hospital’s Integrative Medicine Center, Rehabilitation Services, Cardiac Rehab, and Special Procedures Unit, and provides additional flexibility to meet the expanding demand for both inpatient and outpatient care by freeing up space for a much-needed expansion of the hospital’s emergency department.

SERVING OUR COMMUNITY'S NEEDS

Griffin's commitment to healthy communities is widespread and diverse, ranging from its participation on the Valley Council of Health and Human Service Organizations, a provider network that works collaboratively to plan and create services and systems designed to improve the equality of life in the Naugatuck Valley community, to the Valley Parish Nurse Program, representing more than 35 parishes throughout the Valley and surrounding area.

Each year, the Griffin Hospital Mobile Health Resource center provides health screenings and other on-site services to more than 11,000 community residents in neighborhoods and businesses, senior centers, shopping centers, and community events and fairs.

The hospital's Health Resource Center, located off Griffin's main lobby, houses one of the largest collections of consumer health information in the country. More than 15,000 physicians, staff, volunteers, and community members use the center each year. As part of its commitment to empowering patients through information and education, Griffin hosts a 10-week Mini Med School program each fall, as well as a series of weekly Health Empowerment talks by physicians and other providers.

The Yale-Griffin Prevention Research Center (PRC) is funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and is the only hospital-based program of its kind. The PRC receives in excess of \$3 million in annual grant funding to perform research committed to developing innovative public health interventions for the Lower Naugatuck Valley, New Haven, Bridgeport, and Hartford.

Griffin Hospital collaborates with its local United Way and YMCA to promote an annual "Corporate Cup" competition, which encourages a company-wide commitment to health, fitness, and wellness activities among area businesses.
