**M**idState Medical Center, in Meriden, Connecticut, is an acute-care hospital serving Meriden, Wallingford, Southington, Cheshire, and adjoining towns.

MidState offers a new, modern, comfortable facility with a full range of sophisticated services, qualified physicians and staff, and state-of-the-art technology. Its focus on quality and on superior patient amenities, such as offering only private rooms for inpatients, has propelled MidState into the top tier of hospitals nationally and in Connecticut, based on independent, monthly patient-satisfaction ratings.

Approximately 50,000 patients from surrounding communities visit MidState's **Emergency Department** (ED) annually, which features comprehensive onsite radiological services and MidState's full complement of service and surgical options, resulting in reduced waiting time and responsive, quality emergency service.

To continue meeting the needs of the communities it serves, MidState is currently undergoing construction for a two-year expansion project that will give birth to a new, enlarged Emergency Department, additional inpatient beds and patient amenities, such as a designated main entrance and covered drop-off area.

## BENEFITING THE CENTRAL CONNECTICUT COMMUNITY

MidState offers preventive care and wellness education, ambulatory surgery and procedures, inpatient and emergency care, individual and family support, rehabilitation and follow-up services – all under one roof.

The Hospital's **Cancer Center** program, for example, features the most advanced diagnostic and treatment technology available. MidState's 64-slice CT scanner offers physicians the detailed internal views they need for advanced diagnosis, evaluation, and treatment. And with other advanced radiological imaging tools including MRI, PET scans and nuclear medicine – all in a digital environment – MidState offers fast turnaround and experienced diagnostic services such as **Intensity Modulated Radiation Therapy** (IMRT). This technology delivers higher doses of carefully targeted radiation directly to cancer cells, while sparing surrounding tissues and organs.

MidState's accredited **Wound and Hyperbaric Care Center** was established in 2004. Only a few hospitals in Connecticut offer mono-hyperbaric oxygen chambers. Close to 90 percent of MidState's wound care patients are successfully completing therapy for problem wounds that – in the past – often resulted in amputations and continuing chronic problems.

The **Spine and Pain Institute**, which opened onsite in 2006, uses an interdisciplinary approach and the most advanced medical therapies available to treat and minimize pain. The professional team also provides a goal-oriented treatment program for those suffering chronic pain.

MidState's **Digestive Health Center** includes an endoscopy laboratory used for examining and treating a range of digestive conditions onsite. With gastroenterologists' clinical offices and MidState's surgical center in the same building, patients can visit one location for all of

their digestive health needs.

Patients can also receive comprehensive testing and treatment for balance problems from MidState's new Balance & Hearing Institute.

With its **Family Birthing Center** and **Sleep Care Center**, MidState can meet most patient needs conveniently and efficiently. In addition, MidState's **Heart Center** offers sophisticated cardiac monitoring, critical care, and rehabilitation.

## CONVENIENT, COMPREHENSIVE, AND EASILY ACCESSIBLE

MidState specializes in minimally invasive and laparoscopic surgical procedures, bariatric, and thoracic/vascular surgeries, and the Hospital is committed to a healthcare team model that promotes collaboration across medical disciplines.

Surgeons at MidState are using laparoscopy – which results in faster recovery time, less pain, and smaller scars – for a variety of surgical procedures. They also specialize in arthroscopic surgery for sports injuries and more complex orthopedic procedures such as joint replacement or minimally invasive neck- and back-related surgery.

Many regional physicians have their clinical practice offices located in the medical office building right in the Hospital, easing scheduling and access to surgery and to MidState's Emergency Department. Without leaving the building, patients also can complete diagnostic testing, visit MidState's radiology services, and schedule procedures.

MidState also supports seniors' health needs through the LaPlanche Clinic at the Meriden Senior Center, and treats more than 17,000 local residents each year at its Medi-Quick Walk-in Health Center on the east side of Meriden. In May 2006, the MidState Medical Group Walk-In Center officially opened on Route 68 in Yalesville. In addition to treatment of minor and/or chronic medical problems, the Center offers a comprehensive workers compensation program and performs school and camp physicals. The Hospital has satellite locations in Cheshire and in Southington for radiology, lab work, and ambulatory care/physician offices.

MidState sponsors or conducts a variety of health-related workshops, educational forums, multi-lingual support groups, and special events throughout the region, all year round. The Hospital also offers health-related blood pressure, osteoporosis, and cholesterol screening clinics at employer sites and health fairs, often collaborating with local libraries, YMCAs, faith-based organizations, and senior centers.
