Services include inpatient hospital care, outpatient medical testing in a variety of community settings, maternity, rehabilitation, inpatient and outpatient behavioral health, eldercare, women's health, home care, and long-term care. ECHN's commitment to preserving and improving health also includes educational programs, screenings, support groups, fitness programs, publications and much more.

SERVING OUR COMMUNITY'S NEEDS

Community Health Promotion (CHP) Department

ECHN offers hundreds of health education programs each year to the east-of-the-river communities it serves through lectures, screenings, special events, classes, health fairs, and support groups. Many of these programs are listed on the ECHN website and in *HealthSource* catalog, which is mailed three times a year to over 45,000 households. In addition, the CHP department offers a speakers' bureau of ECHN medical professionals who are available to speak to local community groups on various health topics.

Community-Based Services

ECHN's broad spectrum of community-based services is designed to improve access to health information and healthcare, with the ultimate goal of improving quality of life. Highlights include:

Behavioral Health Department

- Adolescent, Adult, and Geriatric Inpatient and Outpatient Services
- Adolescent Day School – a fully accredited school for boys and girls with behavioral health issues
- Horizons Case Management – helps adults with psychiatric disorders to live safely and independently
- Work Source – supports clients' efforts to secure meaningful jobs

Breast & Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program

Access to critical breast and cervical cancer screening services is provided through free or low-cost mammograms and Pap tests for underserved women.

Fetal & Infant Mortality Review (FIMR)

Compassionate support and resources are provided to families when there is a loss of a pregnancy or an infant. FIMR also works to make changes in the community to strengthen services available for women, children and families to help prevent losses.

Disease-Management Programs

On-site programs for diabetes self-management, cardiac rehabilitation, and pulmonary rehabilitation stress education and offer support.

Family Development Center (FDC)

Fostering positive parenting and encouraging family-focused activities, the FDC services include programs for school readiness (Early Head Start), young parents support, parent education, after-school and preschool programs, and educational play groups.

In-Home Services

Through our partnership with Visiting Nurse & Health Services of Connecticut, ECHN provides cardiac rehabilitation services in patients' homes. Services include case management, education, monitored exercise, and communication with cardiologists.

School-Based Health Centers

Located in three East Hartford schools, these centers offer counseling, primary care, and dental hygiene services for children from kindergarten through high school.
