Hartford HealthCare Proposes Health Center in Mystic

STONINGTON —Hartford HealthCare has proposed a multi-million-dollar health center next to Mystic’s major tourism destinations that would provide a wide array of medical services including primary and specialty care.

If approved by the town the 47,000-square-foot facility off I-95 and Coogan Boulevard in the Mystic section of Stonington would include:

- Primary care
- Cardiology
- Imaging
- Rehabilitation
- Infusion services
- Headache center
- Movement disorders center
- Other neuroscience and specialty services
- Community education facilities
- Space for additional future offerings

“We are very excited about the opportunity to provide shoreline residents more convenient access to world-class, high-quality health services,” said Jeffrey Flaks, Hartford HealthCare’s President and Chief Operating Officer. “Our strategic investment in this important region will allow us to better coordinate care and aligns perfectly with Hartford HealthCare’s wide range of healthcare offerings along the shoreline — from Rhode Island to Old Lyme.”

The proposed health center is located next to the Mystic Aquarium at the Perkins Farm Campus, which is a large mixed-use development that also includes housing for active adults as well as young professionals like those recently hired by Electric Boat. The health center is designed to provide the most advanced medical care to surrounding shoreline and inland communities.

“The Hartford HealthCare HealthCenter at Mystic will be the most state-of-the-art medical facility in Southeastern Connecticut,” developer and owner David Lattizori said. “The center is designed to take advantage of 21st-century building materials which will communicate to patients and the community that this is a world-class medical facility.”

It will have one of the best locations in Mystic with easy access from Coogan Boulevard and Exit 90 off I-95 and will be the premier medical destination along the Connecticut shoreline for quality medical care, Lattizori added.

The project’s site plan application will be submitted to Stonington’s Planning Department on Nov. 16 followed by a hearing before the town’s Planning and Zoning Board the beginning of January. If approved, construction would start soon thereafter.
