Dr. Camelia Lawrence Joins Fairfield County Medical Association Board

Dr. Lawrence is the Director of Breast Surgery at the Hospital of Central Connecticut and Midstate Medical Center and she is a member of the Hartford HealthCare Cancer Institute. She is an Assistant Professor of Surgery at the University of Connecticut School of Medicine. Before joining the Hartford HealthCare Cancer Institute, she practiced at St. Vincent's Medical Center in Bridgeport.

Dr. Lawrence earned her medical degree from the Rochester School of Medicine and Dentistry, completed her General Surgery Residency from the Western Medical Center / New York Medical College, and Breast Surgical Oncology Fellowship from the John Wayne Cancer Institute.

She has been recognized numerous times for her work in the field of breast cancer and community service, including the 2018 Ljilal Muhammad Humanitarian Award, the 2018 Connecticut 100 Women of Color Award, the 2017 Women Leading the Way Honor, the 2017 Doctors of Distinction award for Female Trailblazers, the 2017 Susan G. Komen More Than Pink Honor, the 2015 Connecticut Woman of Power Award, the 2010 Lynn Sage Breast Cancer Achievement Award, the 2004 Dr. Kenneth Woodward Memorial Award and the 2002 Dr. Edwin Robinson Humanitarian Award.

In addition to the Fairfield County Medical Association, Dr. Lawrence also serves on the board of the City Lights Gallery, The Susan G. Komen, Northeast organization, the Connecticut Department of Health Early Breast Cancer Detection Advisory group, and the Discovery Museum.

Dr. Lawrence lives with her family in Shelton, CT.
