This year's virtual conference will focus on the introduction and implementation of AIM (Alliance for Innovation on Maternal Health) in Connecticut. AIM is a national data-driven maternal safety and quality improvement initiative based on interdisciplinary consensus-based practices to improving maternal safety and outcomes.

We will hear from Dr. Elliott Main—national expert on severe hypertension in pregnancy, learn about how to construct and conduct effective high and low tech simulations, and better understand how severe hypertension in pregnancy affects the neonate.
